

# Affordable Housing of Paso Robles 2023 Impact Report

## The AHPR Story

Affordable Housing of Paso Robles was established as a supporting organization of Paso Robles Housing Authority (PRHA) to develop affordable housing. The initial developments are the four phase Oak Park Community affordable housing projects located in Paso Robles, CA. Subsequently since 2013, four phases have been completed consisting of 321 new LIHTC units on approximately 20 acres.

Additionally, AHPR provides tenant services and runs a community service program known as YouthWorks for the community of Oak Park. YouthWorks is an after-school educational and employability skills program transforming the lives of children ages four to twenty-one. Originally founded by PRHA in the summer of 2011 with six high school students. The YouthWorks program has grown to over 200 children, and continues to expand. YouthWorks programming occurs throughout the year including school and holiday breaks. All YouthWorks programs are free of charge.

"YouthWorks is a great place because it's giving the youth of our community a head start in the working world. Our program has been made so we can offer a safe and beneficial environment to kids making their way through life. Being at YouthWorks inspires me to be the best version of myself, aim for my goals and not let fear stop me from what i'm capable of.
